

Tactical Sight Instructions

**BEFORE INSTALLING THIS SIGHT,
BE SURE THE GUN IS UNLOADED
AND POINTED IN A SAFE
DIRECTION.**

The dual range tactical sight is designed for close-in as well as long range, 100 yard plus precision shooting without changing the sight adjustment.

Recommended sight-in procedure

1. For upper receivers with elevation adjustment, set the rear elevation to the lowest position.
2. Sight-in rifle at 100 or 200 yards using stationary crosshair and rotating TACTICAL sight for correct elevation. Fine tune by using the elevation and windage adjustment on the rear sight.
3. Fire rifle at close range target (15, 20, 25 yards) again using stationary crosshairs. Bullet impact will be low.
4. Hold rifle steady with stationary crosshairs on close target bullseye. Without moving rifle, adjust the vertical crosshair ball to the center of the bullet hole using the supplied .035 hex wrench.
5. For a permanent hold, use a small amount of blue thread locker on the vertical adjustment.
